LCES Checklist

Briefing

1. Pre-planned LCES
2. Common communications
3. Adhere to tactical guidelines
4. All personnel informed
5. Re-evaluate and update

Escape Routes

1. More than one route
2. Scouted: Soils/Rocks/Vegetation
3. Time: Slowest person/ Fatigue/Heat factors
4. Marked: Flagged for day/night

Lookouts and Communications

1. Experienced / Competent
2. Enough Lookouts at good vantage points
3. Establish LCES for Lookouts
4. Knowledge of personnel locations
5. Update on any changes
6. Map/ Weather kit/ Watch/ IAP
7. Radio frequencies, backups, check-ins
8. Sound alarm early, don't wait

Safety Zones

1. Survivable without fire
2. Natural: Clean burn/Rock areas/Water
3. Man-made: Constructed sites/Roads
4. Vehicles for escape
5. Upslope/Downwind/Hvy Fuel=Lgr. Zone
